EXAMPLES OF ELIGIBLE WEATHERIZATION ACTIVITIES vs. REHABILITATION ACTIVITIES

Feature or System	Weatherization Activities	Rehabilitation Activities
Site		- o New landscaping throughout an area - o Construction of new walkways, driveways or parking areas, or replacement thereof
Building Exterior		- o Cleaning masonry or stripping painted surfaces by sandblasting, acid wash, or high pressure washing - o Applying new exterior siding
Roof	- o In-kind replacement of loose or missing shingles or tiles for energy efficiency - o Chimney spark arrestors	- o Complete replacement of roof with new shingles, tiles, roll roofing, membrane, or new metal roof - o Installation of solar panels
Windows and Doors	- o Caulking, weather stripping windows and doors - o Fixing broken windowpane(s), storm window(s) or damaged front door for energy efficiency	- o Replacement of windows - o Replacement of exterior doors - o Adding storm windows or storm doors
Interior Walls and Ceilings	o Insulation for energy efficiency	- o Installation of new drywall or paneling - o Installation of new acoustical ceiling - o Installation of dropped ceilings
Flooring		o Installation of new wood floor
Circulation		- o Rebuilding stair or constructing new stair - o Installation of new access ramp - o Elevator replacement
Kitchen		o Complete or substantial kitchen remodel
Bathroom/Laundry		o Complete or substantial bathroom remodel
HVAC	- o Servicing and maintenance of mechanical systems for energy efficiency - o Replacing a malfunctioning part of a HVAC system like a thermostat for energy efficiency	- o Installation of new furnace or heat distribution system - o Installation of central air conditioning

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Electrical/Lighting		- o Major rewiring of building - o Installation of new electrical service - o Replacing or moving electrical panels
Plumbing		- o Installation of new plumbing system - o New water or sewer connection
Security		- o Installation of permanent security bollards - o Installation of new security alarm system
Life Safety		- o Making substantial physical changes to a building to comply with fire and life safety codes - o Installing fire suppression system
